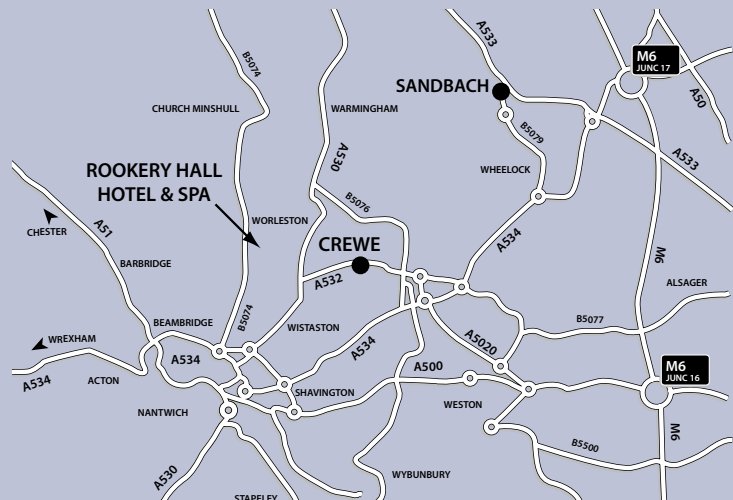
HOW TO FIND US...

The Hotel is easily accessible from the M6 junction 16 take the A500 to Nantwich, follow this road continuing straight over the next 3 roundabouts signposted A500/A51 Chester. At the 4th roundabout, turn right, taking the 3rd exit, still signposted A500/A51 Chester. Continue straight over the next 2 roundabouts. At the final roundabout you should take the third exit, signposted B5074, towards Worleston and Winsford. On the B5074 Rookery Hall Hotel & Spa is 1 mile along this road on the right-hand side.
